Four distinctions of the word "Kingdom" in the Bible (D.A. Carson):

1. The notion of <u>Kingdom</u> often refers to dominion, that is, <u>reign</u>.

2. God rules. He has ultimate authority.

3. The Bible makes <u>distinctions</u> between his reign over all and the <u>life</u> He gives to those who know Him as Lord and Savior.

4. The Bible presents the Kingdom of God as being a <u>present reality</u> and something which will come in the <u>future</u>.
