Intro

1. Our needs will be met through our obedience to God's Word.

Lev. 23:22, Deut. 24:19, Ruth 2:2

2. Our needs will be met through our own hard work.

• We must take initiative. *Ruth 2:2*

• We must be persistent. *Ruth 2:7*

• We must have industry. *Ruth 2:17*

3. Our needs will be met through our own personal faith.

• Faith involves humility about ourselves. *Ruth 2:7, 10, 13*

• Faith involves dependence on God. *Ruth 2:12*

4. Our needs will be met through God's providence.

Ruth 2:1-4, 8-9, 14-16

5. Our needs will be met through God's people. *Ruth 2:20*

Now What?

If we *faithfully* obey, God will *faithfully* provide.

Why does it not always happen in our lives?

- Our needs may not be real needs.
- Our needs are already being met.
- Our needs may be different than we supposed.

What can I do now to have my needs met?

- Determine what concrete steps to take.
- Trust the situation to the Lord through prayer.
- Look for God's hand working in our lives.
