A. We need balance when discussing spiritual gifts-two extremes:	
<u>The Misusers:</u>	The Refusers:
Seek all the gifts	Stop the gifts
Emphasizes the sensational	Denies them all
No control	Overcontrolled
No limits	Completely limited

B. The definition of a spiritual gift is God's endowment of a particular enablement given to each and every believer to empower service for Him.

I. Every individual believer has received at least one spiritual gift. 4:7 (cf. 1 Pet 4:10)

A. God maintains the unity of the body through diversity not uniformity.

B. God not only calls us to serve Him but gives us the divine enablement

to do so.

C. God not only gives the gifts but grants them in different measures.

D. God's gift giver is the Messiah Jesus Himself.

II. The Lord Jesus dispenses spiritual gifts as an outgrowth of His victory over Satan, sin and death. 4:8-10

A. The quotation from Psalm 68 depicts a victorious divine king dispensing gifts

to His people. 4:8

D. Receive guidance and confirmation from a mature believer that

knows you well.

E. Practice the Eureka principle
