THE COACH ROLE:

Disciple Small Group Leaders through **KNOWING**, **LEADING**, **PROTECTING** and **LOVING** them in all things.

KNOW

- **Know** them personally (family, life, etc.)
- Know their heart burdens and personal prayer requests
- Know their spiritual growth points.
- Know their strengths and weaknesses (personally & in leadership)
- Know to whom they are accountable
- Know the individuals in their coaching group by name

LEAD

- **Lead** them by modelling a genuine walk with Christ
- **Lead** them by modelling discipleship and care:
 - Identify and develop future leaders
 - Meet regularly with Small Group Leader.
 - Regularly visit Small Group meetings
 - Train and equip the Small Group Leaders
 - Encourage and energize the Small Group Leaders
 - Motivate the Small Group Leader by casting vision.
 - Speak truth into the life of the Small Group Leader

PROTECT

- **Protect** the Truth.
- Protect the vision and doctrine of the church.
- Protect the quality of Small Group Ministry.
- **Protect** the unity and relationships of Small Groups.
- **Protect** by offering biblical counseling.
- Protect by supporting leadership of the church.

...and in all things LOVE

Shepherd the flock of God that is among you, exercising oversight, not under compulsion, but willingly as God would have you; not for shameful gain, but eagerly; not domineering over those in your charge, but being examples to the flock. And when the chief Shepherd appears, you will receive the unfading crown of glory.
