APPLICATION

Besides the gift of salvation, what is one of your favorite gifts that God has given you?

“God not only calls us to serve Him but gives us the divine enablement to do so” (Dr. Rydelnik). God helps us serve Him by giving us gifts. How do your gifts help you to serve Him? How have you seen “divine enablement” in your life?

Dr. Rydelnik encouraged us to serve in as many areas as possible in the church in order to find where you’re most gifted to serve. What is your current attitude about serving? How does what you learned today about receiving a “particular enablement” encourage you to serve God in the church?

Dr. Rydelnik gave us five ways to discover your spiritual gifts. Which 1-2 can you do this week?

1. Study the gifts in the key passages (Rom. 12:3-9; I Cor. 12-14; 1 Peter 4:10 & 11; Eph. 4: 7-16)
2. Take a gift inventory: harvestbible.org/discovermygifts
3. Identify desires and inclinations
4. Receive guidance and confirmation from a mature believer who knows you well
5. Practice the Eureka principle
 - a. Serving in as many ways as possible
 - b. Discover those areas in which you are most effective/bring you the most joy
 - c. Shout “Eureka!”
