APPLICATION
This was Pastor Jeff's first time in the pulpit with us. What was one of your favorite things about his message?
Pastor Jeff said, "Genuinely committed Christians sow seeds for the harvest." What do you think he meant by this? How are you doing in this area? How can your Small Group encourage you to sow more seeds and grow deeper roots?
