APPLICATION

Pastor Tommy began the sermon talking about collisions. Have you ever been in a collision before? How did
that wake you up and change you?
Take a moment and read the story of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego in Daniel 3. What stuck out to you most in this passage and why?
In Matthew 6:10 Jesus says, "Your will be done". Explain how we know what God's will is for us. How can you know if you're following it? How can you better align with His will over your will?
Explain what it means when you pray "on Earth as it is in Heaven." Where would you like to see Heaven on Earth?
This week, as we look at applying this prayer to our lives, pick a space (country, city, church, family, home, personally), and pray "in, as it is in Heaven".

Prayer is an expression of worship to God. Right now, take time as a group to respond by praising God as your Heavenly Father. And then pray that His kingdom would come, His will would be done, on Earth as it in Heaven.
