1 Chronicles 17:7-15, Matthew 6:10a

APPLICATION

In the intro, Pastor Ed shared examples from popular culture of "kingdoms." What is your favorite movie the reflects the idea of a "kingdom"?
We all are building kingdoms, but the question is: which kingdom is your priority? What are the tensions you face in making the Kingdom of God the priority versus your own personal kingdom?
Read 1 Chronicles 17:7-15. As a group, share what verses stood out to you and why. What did you learn about God? David? Nathan?
Let's dive deeper on Matthew 6:10a. What does it mean to let "Your Kingdom come?" What would the application of this verse look like in your life for the next 30 days?
In most kingdoms, access is limited to the King (either by birth or special invitation). In the Kingdom of God, the King made a way through His Son for anyone to join His Kingdom. What does this tell us about God? Share with each other when you embraced Christ by faith and were transferred into His Kingdom.

As a group, let's respond to God this week in prayer. Pastor Ed issued the challenge of "breath prayers." What will be the "trigger" you use to remember to pray this week? Share it with the group. When it happens, simply utter the words, "Let Your Kingdom Come."
