APPLICATION

Have you ever gotten lost or gone the wrong direction? Tell what happened and how you found your way back. Share about a similar moment in your walk with Christ where you lost your way – a little or a lot. Tell how God drew you back to Himself.

Read Ephesians 1:7-9. Take a moment and talk about what the life of a slave could be like. Now consider: what is it like to be a slave to sin? What does it mean that Christ provides a way for people to be redeemed from “the slave block of sin”?

Read Ephesians 1:10-12. If you’ve embraced Christ for the forgiveness of your sin, you are Christ’s inheritance. In light of that reality, what are some of the right and wrong responses to God’s forgiveness?

Christ forgives in accordance with His wealth. Take a moment and assess how your worship of God has been affected by that truth. How will knowing that impact the way you worship God this Easter?

Dr. Mike offered these three ideas to be doers of the Word this week. Talk together about which one(s) you will do and your plan. Think about how your group can spur one another on.

1. Consider where your individual life would be right now had you not been redeemed from the slave block of sin.

2. Identify one specific way where the Lord Jesus has transformed you by coming to know Him.

3. Name one specific way that the Holy Spirit has marked your individual life, that identifies you as belonging to Him, and then give Him praise for that.
