OPEN YOUR BIBLE TO EPHESIANS 2:10 & 1 CORINTHIANS 12:5-6

**EXPLAIN** God has given each of us talents to use to build His Kingdom. Even kids have talents and things they like to do.

READ Ephesians 2:10 & 1 Corinthians 12:5-6

**ASK** What are some things you like to do? We talked last week about that. (Share with your child what you believe your talents are.)

**PRAY** Heavenly Father, show us how we can use our talents to serve You better and build Your Kingdom. We just want to be used by You. In Jesus name, amen.



### **OPEN YOUR BIBLE TO 1 PETER 4:10-11**

**EXPLAIN** These verses help us understand how we should use our talents. God wants us to use our talents as faithful stewards. A steward doesn't own anything, he/she is responsible to take care of the owner's property. (Our owner is God.)

READ Reread 1 Peter 4:10-11

**ASK** How can we best take care of the talents and gifts God has given us?

**PRAY** Heavenly Father, we love you so much and want to take good care of what You have given us. Please help us to do that for Your glory. In Jesus name, amen.



#### OPEN YOUR BIBLE TO EXODUS 31:3-5 & MATTHEW 5:14-16

**EXPLAIN** Not every gift is singing or teaching the Bible. Some people have gifts that allow them to create beautiful things. God wants us to use those special talents for His glory and do them well so we shine brightly for Him.

**READ** Exodus 31:3-5 & Matthew 5:14-16

**ASK** Why do we sometimes want to take the credit for what God gives us? Why do we want the glory? What should we do when we feel like that?

**PRAY** Heavenly Father, help us to only want to bring You glory through our talent and gifts. When we find ourselves wanting the glory, please help us to refocus on You always. In Jesus name, amen.
