### THE STORY OF GOD

He sent His Son to take our place. God sent Jesus to save us. That’s called Substitution. The next moment in the Gospel story is when we believe by faith that God’s story is true. God invites us to believe in Him because He wants to be with us, He wants to give us life. Let’s talk about that this week.
