## CONCEPT REVIEW

**Supplies:** 5 pieces of paper or note cards printed with the 5 gospel words. (God, sin, substitution, believe and life)

**Instructions:** Hold stack of signs in order so “God” is showing first. We know that at the end of time God’s good news will be sung about and shared in Heaven forever. Psalm 103:19, says, “The LORD has established his throne in the heavens, and his kingdom rules over all.” In heaven right now, because of God’s good news, all of heaven is singing: “Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of hosts; the whole earth is full of his glory!”

(Move “God” sign to back and show the “Sin” sign.) So how do we get to be part of that? God has always had a plan. Because of our sin, we deserved to be punished, but Jesus was punished in our place. Because of our sin we deserved death, but Jesus died for us. The Gospel story starts with God creating everything, and then God watched as man was separated from God through sin.

(Move the “Sin” sign to the back and show the “Substitution” sign.) Then God did the only thing that could fix our broken friendship with Him. God sent His Son to take our place. God sent Jesus to save us. That’s called Substitution.

(Move “Substitution” to the back and show the “Believe” sign.) The next moment in the Gospel story is when we believe by faith that God’s story is true.

(Move “Believe” sign to back and show the “Life” sign.) God invites us to believe in Him because He wants to be with us, He wants to give us life.

So that we can easily remember the Gospel story and tell it to others, this month we will learn five words... God, Sin, Substitution, Believe and Life. Although it’s not perfect, and there is so much more to tell about God, these are five good words to help us remember the best news ever –the Gospel. Can we say that together? God is Gospel. It’s really good news!



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
