3. What was Paul's view of his imprisonment? Why was he able to have this view?
4. Paul was placed in prison, where he was given the opportunity to tell the Roman guards the Gospel. Where has God placed you in life? Do you seek to advance the gospel with those around you?
5. Paul's perspective on life is inspiring. What does he say about how he lives his life in vv. 20-26? Where do you see a need for more spiritual growth in your life?
6. Paul's view of life and death is stated in Philippians 1:21-23. What happens at death for the follower of Christ, according to Paul? See also 2 Corinthians 5:1-10; Luke 23:43.
