Read Matthew 2:1-23
1. Why was king Herod and all Jerusalem troubled when they heard the news of the birth of the king of the Jews? (See Mt. 2:3).
2. What sort of investigating did Herod do to find about more about the birth of Jesus? (See Mt. 2:4-7).
3. What 'motivation' did Herod give to the wise men for his inquiry into the birth of Jesus (Mt. 2:8)? What was his real motivation (Mt. 2:3, 12-18)?
4. Why did Herod reject Jesus as king?
5. What does Herod's inquiry regarding the birthplace of the Messiah say about his belief in the prophets (Mt 2:4-6)? Does he believe in them? If so, then what does that say about his desire to kill Jesus the Messiah?

- 6. What O.T passage did the chief priests and scribes cite as evidence that the Messiah would be born in Jerusalem (Mt. 2:5-6)?
- 7. Matthew 2:4-6 does not explicitly say that the religious leaders were indifferent to the birth of Jesus, so why did Pastor Cory accuse them of this in his message?

- 8. Why were the religious leaders indifferent to the birth of Jesus?
- 9. Herod had reasons for his hostility, and the religious leaders had reasons for their indifference. Do you know anyone who is hostile and/or indifferent to Jesus? What might be their reason(s)? How might you help them overcome this?
